## "Sparkling Tales, Shaping Futures: EYP Storytelling Spectacle"

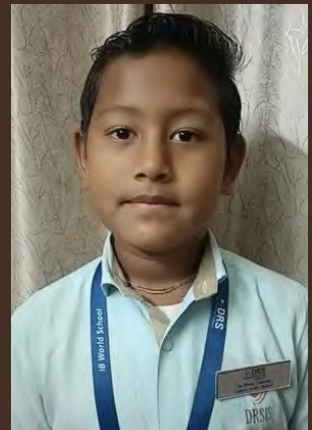

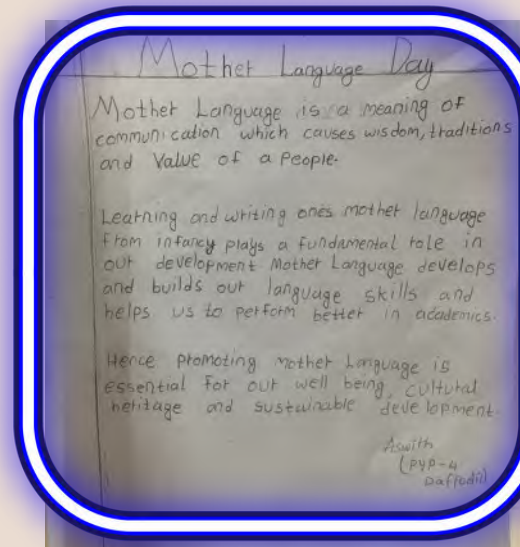


# MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

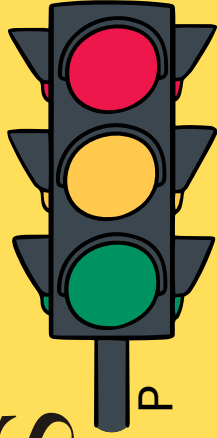


## **IK 2 – GROWING CURIOSITY: EXPLORING PLANTS AT LAKE VIEW FRONT**

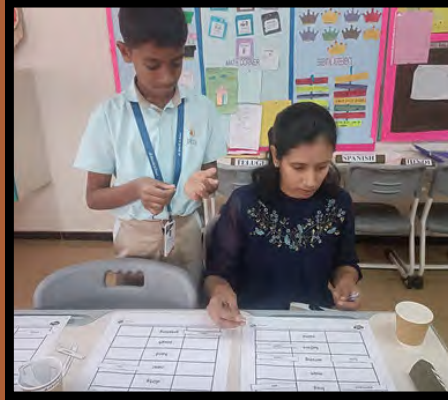
## Empowering Growth: Student-Led Conference

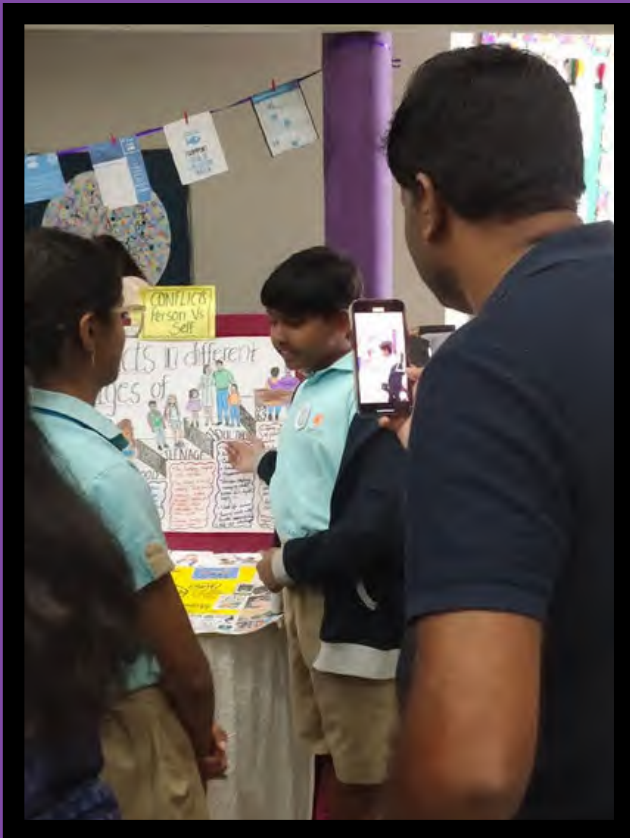
## Empowering Young Changemakers

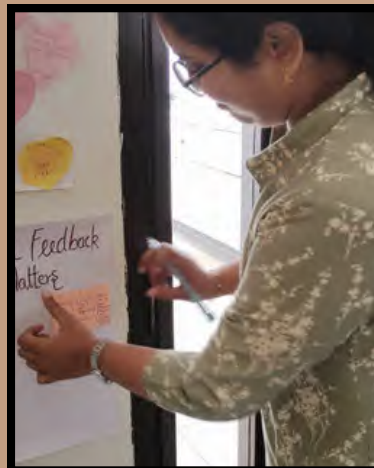
